4. Short description

7. Instructions

Method of play:

Step 1: Place the 6 buses face up on the center of the table and distribute the other passenger tokens among the players.

Step 2: In turns, each player rolls the dice and according to the differentiating element that comes out, he completes the corresponding bus with one of his counters. If there are no passengers with the differentiating element that indicates the dice, the turn is passed to the next player.

Step 3: The winner is the player who runs out of chips first.

As there are 6 buses in this game, up to 6 players can play at the same time. If there are fewer players, each player can play with more than one bus at the same time.

Cooperative version:

Step 1: Place the buses on their back in the centre of the table, on the one hand, and the characters with the different differentiating elements, on the other.

Step 2: In turns, each player rolls the dice and, depending on the differentiating element that comes out, looks for a piece with a character that carries that differentiating element and places it where it belongs. If there are no more checkers left with the differentiating element that indicates the die, the turn is over.

Step 3: The game ends when all the buses have been completed.



ACTIVITIES:

1. Association:

With the cards placed face-upwards in the centre of the table, each player should pick up and place in his/her bus the people who have the same differentiating element as the one on the side of his/her bus.

2. Memory:

With the cards placed face-downwards in the centre of the table, each player, in order, should turn over one card. If the person is wearing/carrying the differentiating element that matches his bus, he can pick it up and place in the bus; if not, he should turn it over again in the same place and the turn passes to the next player.

3. Language:

Step 1: Each player chooses a person and describes them, saying whether it's a boy or a girl, a child or an adult, what differentiating element they are wearing /carrying, what kind of clothes they are wearing, etc.

Step 2: With the cards placed face-upwards around the table, a player makes a description of one of the people. The other players have to listen and observe attentively to be the first to identify and pick up the card of the person he/she is talking about.

Step 3: Once the bus has been filled with its 6 passengers, each player invents a story that links them together.

Step 4: A player selects various people with different elements at random and invents a story relating them.

Step 5: Each player chooses a person and invents a short story about them which should then be picked up and continued by another player involving another person.

8. Additional information

• The game consists of filling each bus with the 6 matching passengers by matching the differentiating element they are wearing or carrying with the picture on the side of each bus.

The people are distinguished by one of 6 differentiating elements:

- Baseball cap
- Book
- Bobble hat
- Ice-cream
- Bunch of flowers
- Glasses
