## 4. Short description

This amazing puppy not only looks lifelike, but he also has authentic sounds and feels like a real puppy! The dog has a nice soft coat. In addition, the puppy responds to movement, but also to petting and cuddling, this is due to the built-in sensors. Of course, the dog should also relax. He will do this during a cuddle session. He closes his eyes and the enjoyment can begin. If the dog is not petted for a few minutes, the eyes will also close and he will go to sleep. With a pat on the back, he wakes up again.

This pet has been specially developed for elderly care, but is certainly also intended for everyone else. It is a companion animal for everyone! Under the fur on his belly is an on-off switch and a possibility to turn off the sound.

Operates on 4 x C (LR14) alkaline batteries (included).

## 9. Installation

1. Turn the dog over and find the opening at the bottom (on the belly).
2. Open the opening to make the switch visible.
3. You can now control the switch.
  - a. When you slide the switch to 'OFF', the dog is completely off. It does not move or make any noise. The dog is on this stand when you take it out of the package. This mode saves battery, for when you do not use the dog for a few days.
  - b. When you slide the switch to 'MUTE', the dog is silent. All other movements will continue.
  - c. When you slide the switch to 'ON', the dog is completely on. He can move and make noise.

## 10. Maintenance

- If dirt gets on the dog, remove it immediately.
- Do not use detergents and/or stain removers. Use a damp cloth to remove dirt.
- The collar is removable and can be washed in the same way as the dog's coat.
- Never immerse the dog under water.

## 11. Replacing batteries

1. Open the opening under the dog (on his belly).
2. Open the hole by turning the screws out.
3. Remove the old batteries
4. Replace it with 4 new 1.5-VOLT C size alkaline batteries.
5. Put the lid back on by tightening the screws again. Close the Velcro again.
6. To see if the batteries are working, check if the switch is set to 'ON' or 'MUTE'.

### IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

#### CAUTION:

##### 1. TO AVOID BATTERY LEAKAGE

- a. Always follow the instructions carefully. Use only batteries specified and be sure to insert them correctly by matching the + and - polarity markings.
- b. Do not mix old batteries and new batteries or standard (carbon-zinc) with alkaline batteries.
- c. Remove exhausted or dead batteries from the product.
- d. Remove batteries if product is not to be played with for a long time.
- e. Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- f. RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES: Do not mix these with any other types of batteries. Always remove from the product before recharging. Recharge batteries under adult supervision. DO NOT RECHARGE OTHER TYPES OF BATTERIES.

2. Should this product cause, or be affected by, local electrical interference, move it away from other electrical equipment. Reset (switching off and back on again or removing and re-inserting batteries) if necessary.



## 12. Instructions for use:



When you stroke the dog's cheeks, he will press his head against your hand.

If you stroke the back of his cup, he will start to move.



If you talk to the dog, he will look at you and he will respond with dog sounds and the BarkBack™ technology.

If you do not touch the dog for a few minutes, he will go to sleep. To wake him up, you can give him a nice pat on the head.



## 13. Functions of the dog

There is a sensor in the following places on the dog:

- Between the ears
- On the head (light sensor)
- On the cheeks
- On the mouth
- On the back
- Microphone

These sensors respond to movement and touch.
